Quest International is committed to preserving the confidentiality, integrity and availability of all physical and electronic information assets throughout the organization, in order to preserve and maintain operational resilience and to ensure legal, regulatory and contractual compliance. Information and information security requirements will continue to be aligned with Quest's goals. Quest's Information and Security Management System (ISMS) is intended to be an enabling system for information sharing, business operations, and managing information-related risks.

Business continuity and contingency plans, avoidance of security breaches, access control to systems and information security incident reporting are fundamental aspects to this Policy. Control objectives for each of these areas are contained in this Manual (Doc. QM-MD-EM-IS) and supported by specific documented policies and procedures.

All Quest Personnel and External Security Support Partners are expected to conform to this policy and will be trained accordingly to ensure understanding and compliance with these requirements.
